Fireblight and Rat-Tail Bloom: May 21, 2022

Most blocks of apples and pears are at petal fall but there is still some rat-tail bloom out there, and late bloom on newly planted trees that is susceptible to Fireblight. Make sure all trees with open flowers that were not sprayed with Strep are covered by tonight. DO NOT spray until temperatures drop to below 85 degrees - looks like that will be around 7 pm.
